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## FOREWORD

The new Kwame Nkrumah University of Science and Technology (KNUST) consists of six Colleges, namely; College of Agriculture and Natural Resources, College of Architecture and Planning, College of Engineering, College of Health Sciences, College of Science and College of Art and Social Sciences. The creation of the colleges is to decentralized functions and responsibilities, to enhance efficiency.

The aim of this publication is to present to our guests and the general public statistical information about the new Kwame Nkrumah University of Science and Technology. The information covers students' numbers and staff strength of the University.

For the 2004/05 academic year, out of the 12,242 qualified applicants (Undergraduate 11,239, and postgraduate 1003), the University admitted 7,764 representing 63.4% (6,971 undergraduates (62%) and 739 (79%). The admission was an increment of 40% over last year's.

The number of candidates admitted from less endowed schools increased from 59 to 329. Plans are underway to increase the number to 1000. KNUST's student enrolment for the 2004/05 academic year was 16,316, with 11,696 (72%) being males and 4620 (28%), being females.

The foreign population is 508, (representing 3% of the total) with the College of Engineering recording the highest number of 254. On the whole, student residential status declined slightly from 46.8% in the last academic year to 45.7%. However, numerically, it increased from 6,777 last year to 7453. This means that over 54% of the population are non-residential.

The University has produced 40,810 graduates since 1962. This year, 3,326 graduands are coming out; 890(26.8%) are females of which 34 were able to obtain First Class.

The academic staff (including part-timers) of the University is 706 and is being supported by 2,694 non-teaching staff.

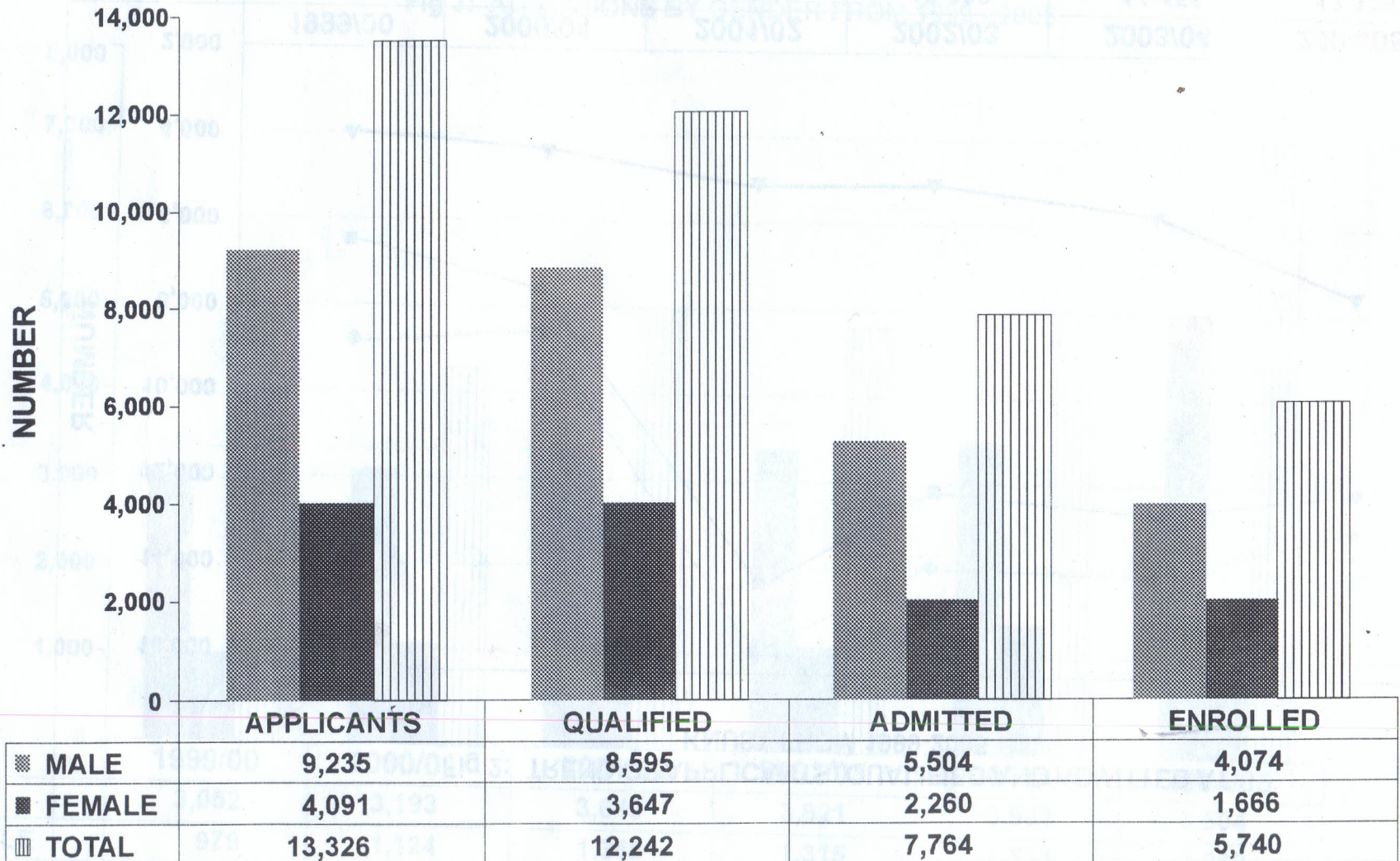
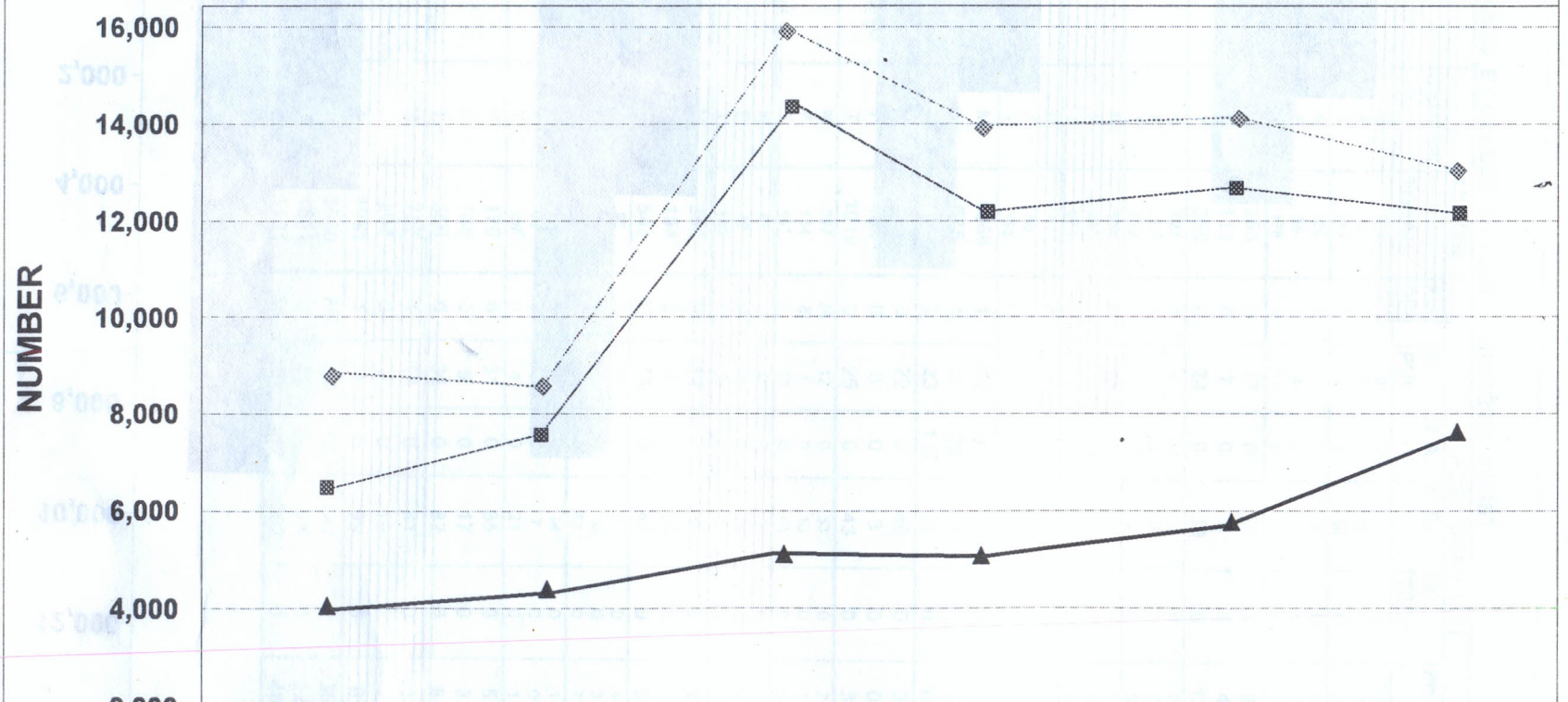




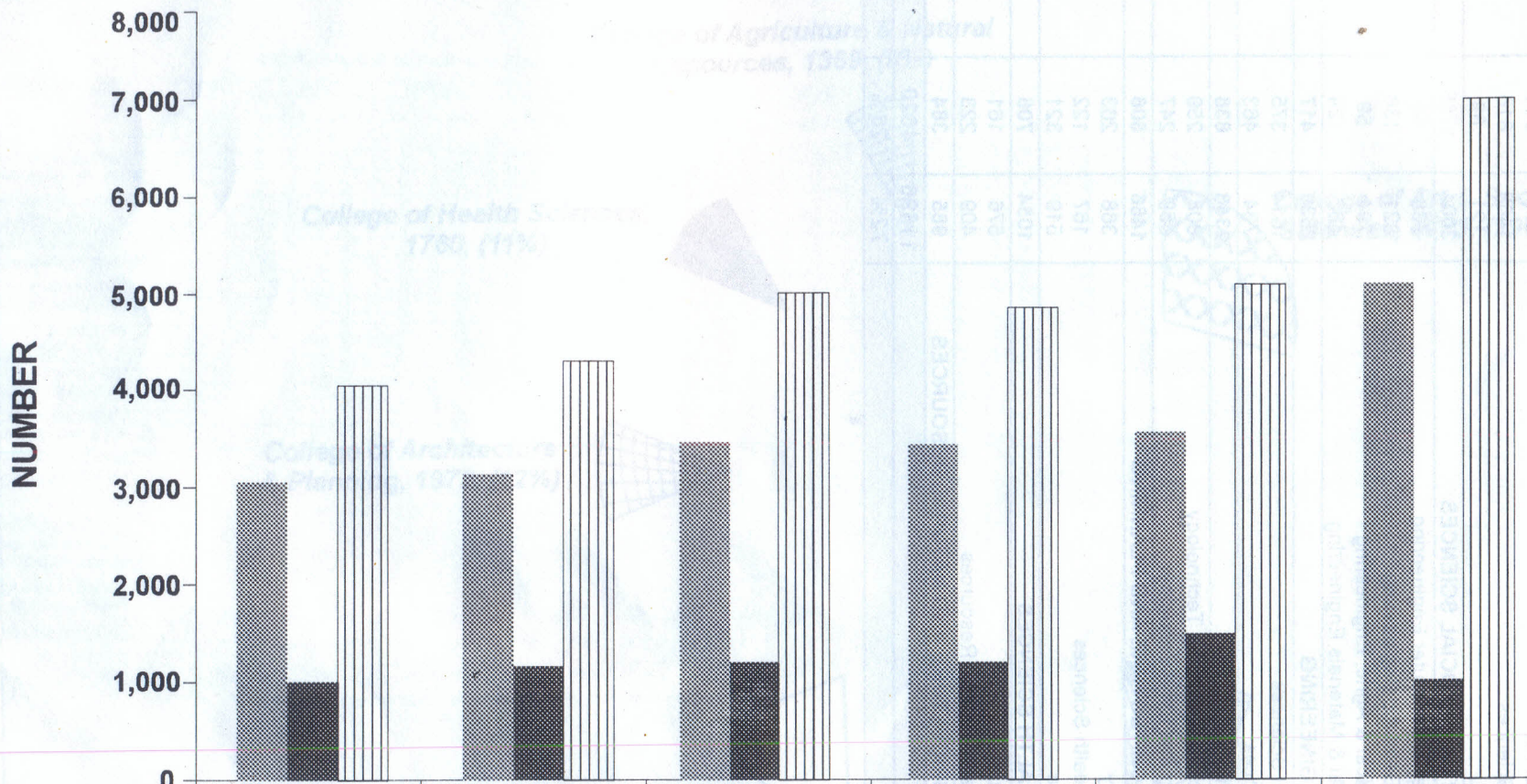
Fig 2: TREND OF APPLICANTS, QUALIFIED AND ADMITTED AT KNUST FROM 1999-2005

Fig 4: STUDENT ENROLMENT BY COLLEGE, NUMBER AND PERCENTAGE (%)

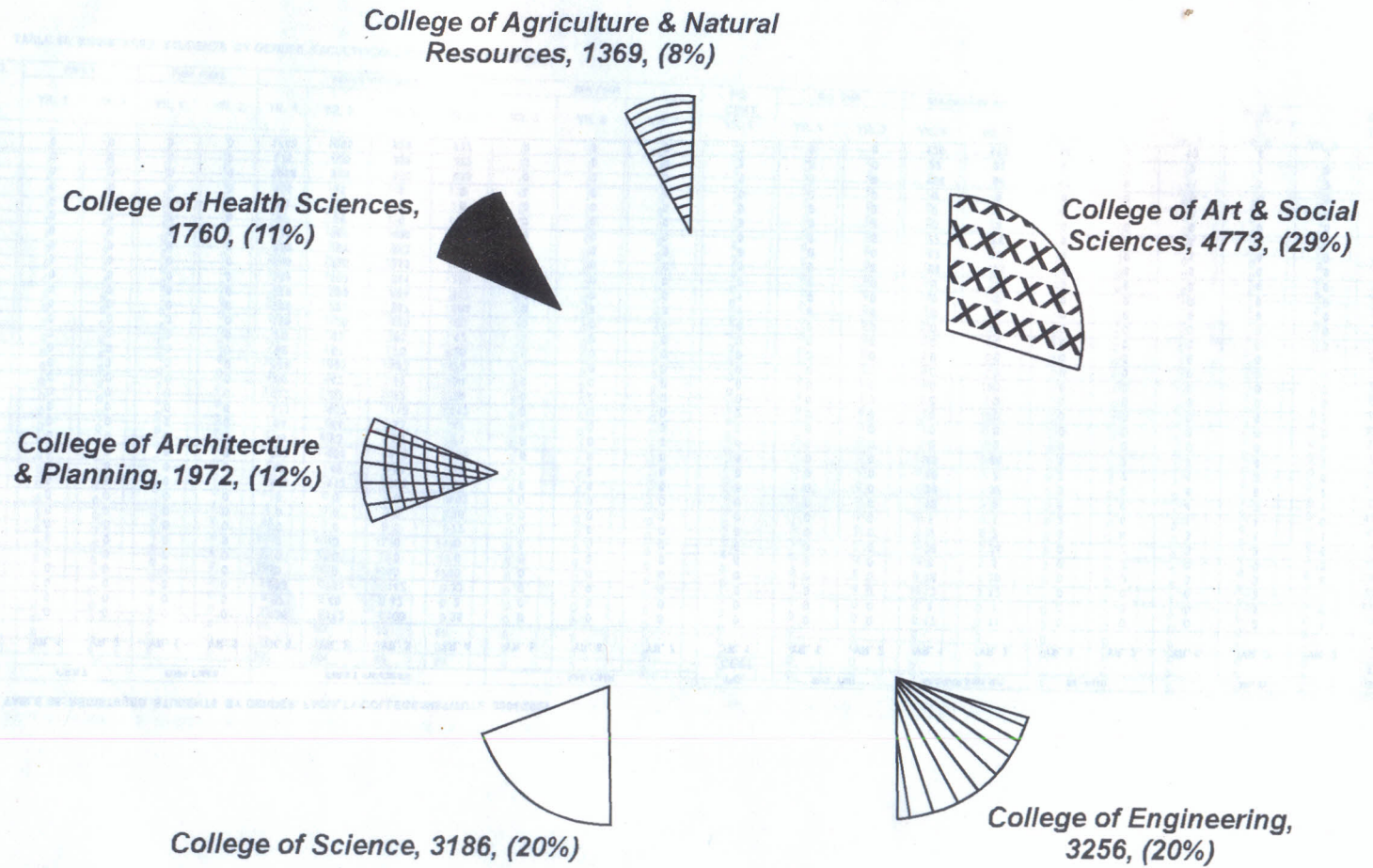

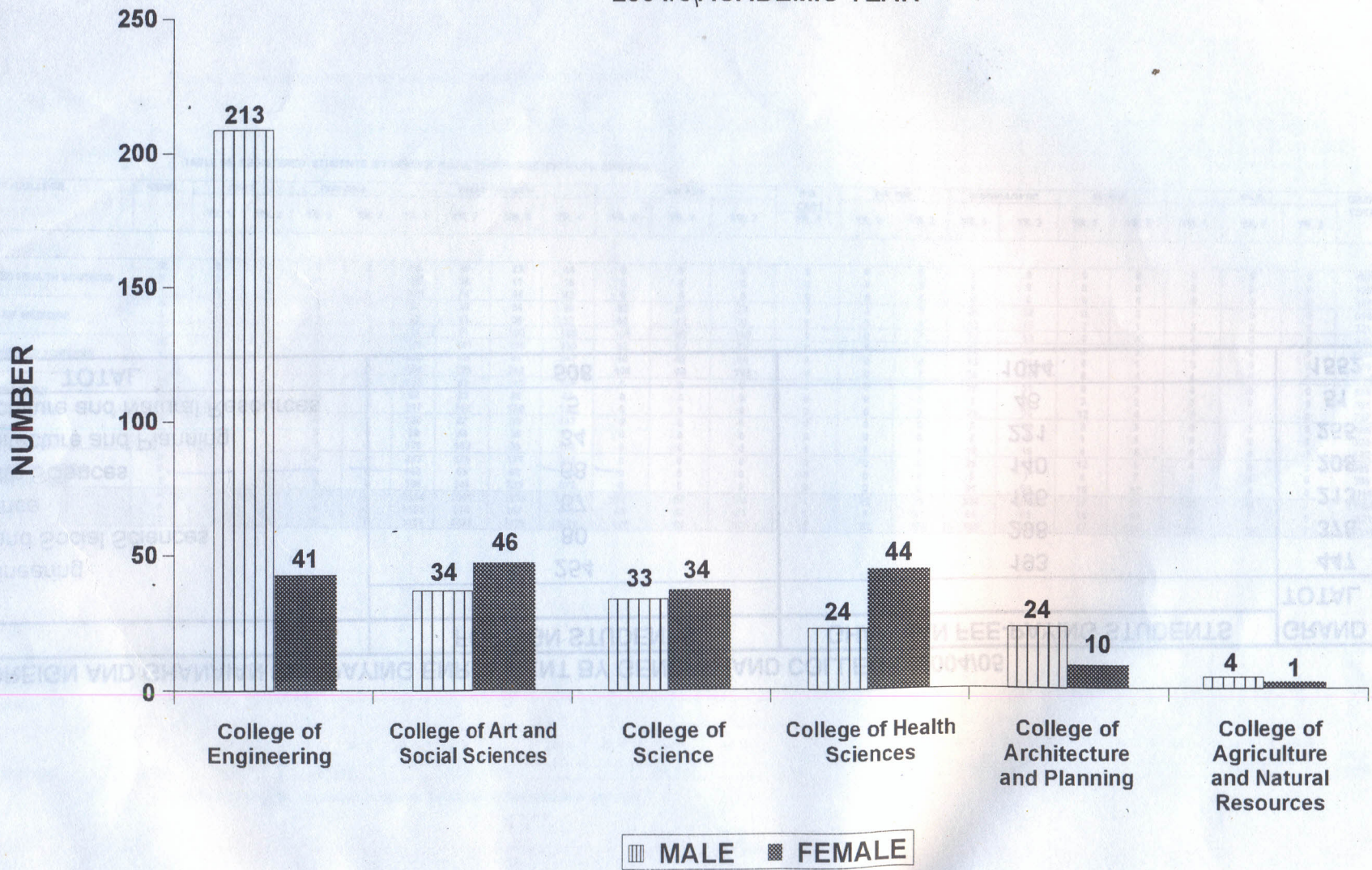

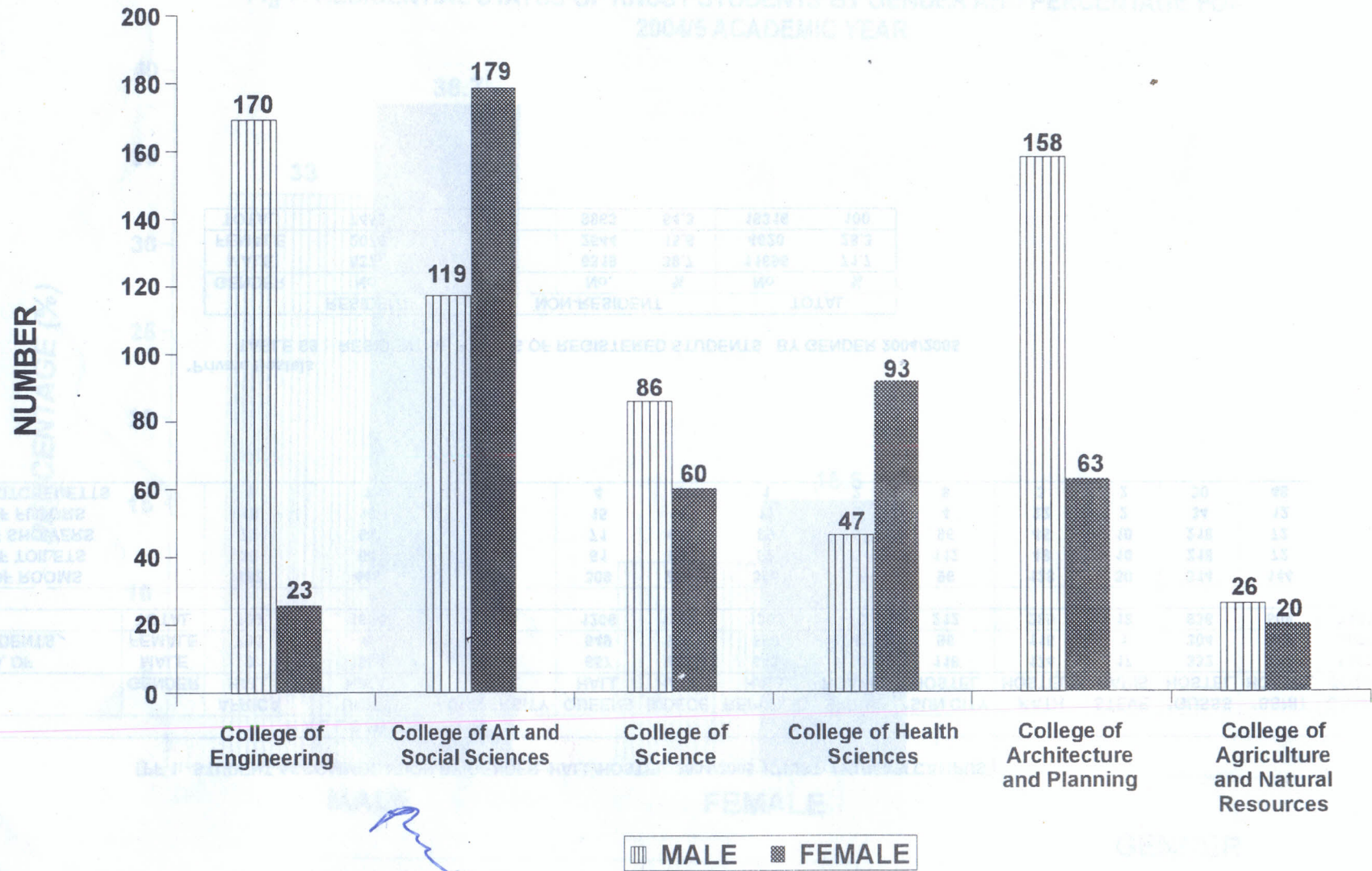
Fig 5: FOREIGN STUDENTS ENROLMENT BY GENDER AND COLLEGE FOR THE 2004/5, ACADEMIC YEAR

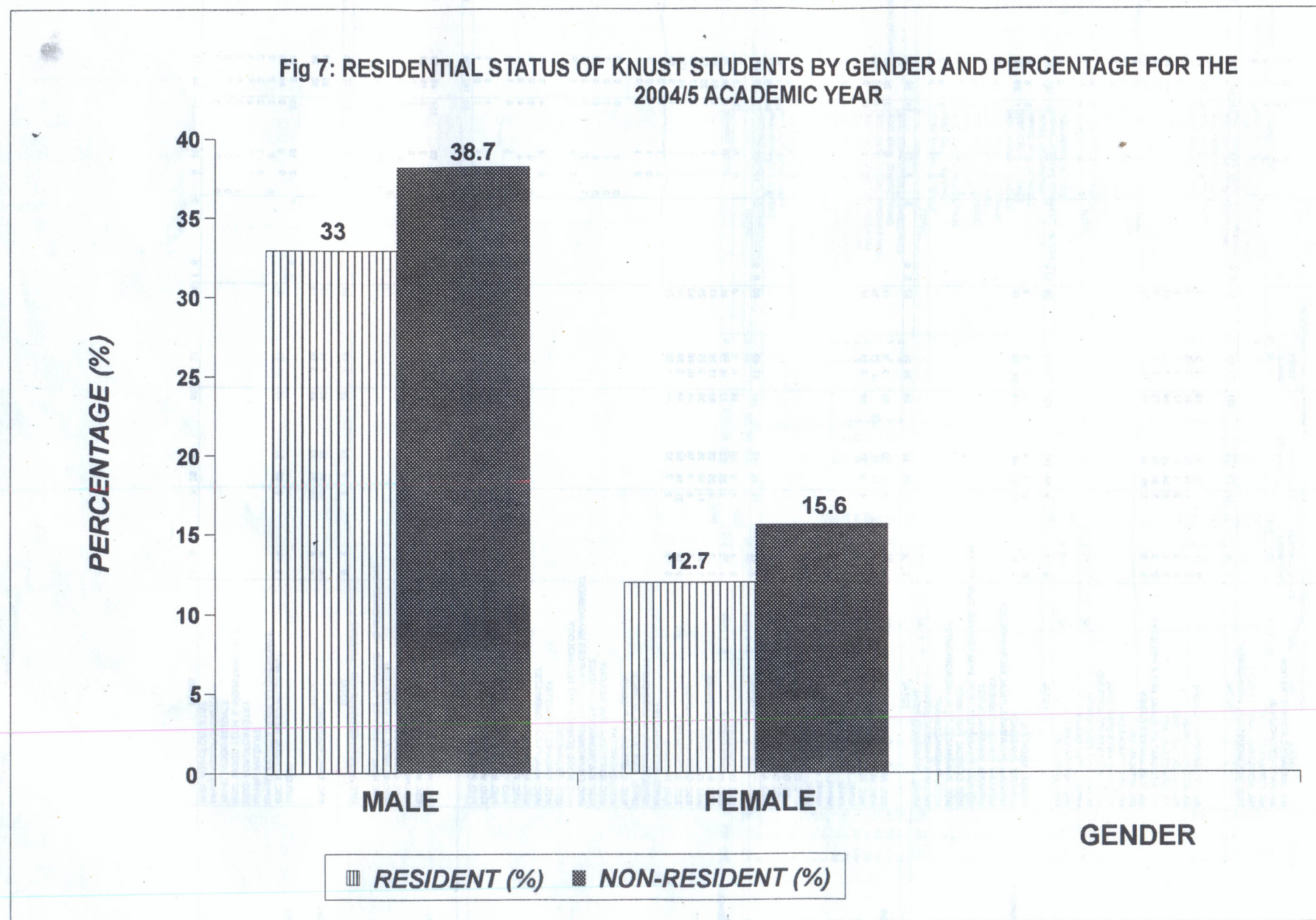

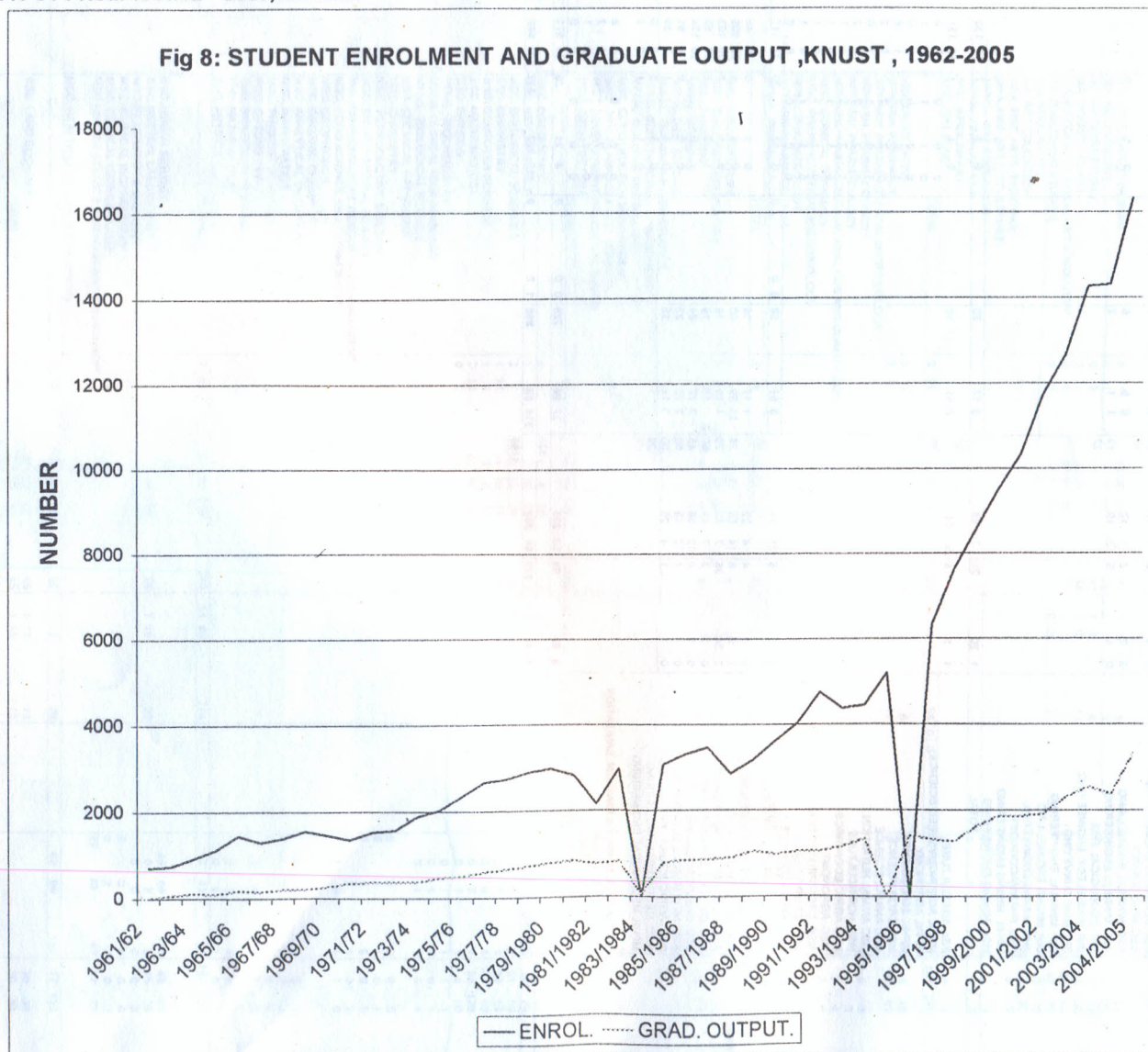

**Fig 9 : DISTRIBUTION OF ACADEMIC STAFF(FULL AND PART TIME) BY COLLEGE**

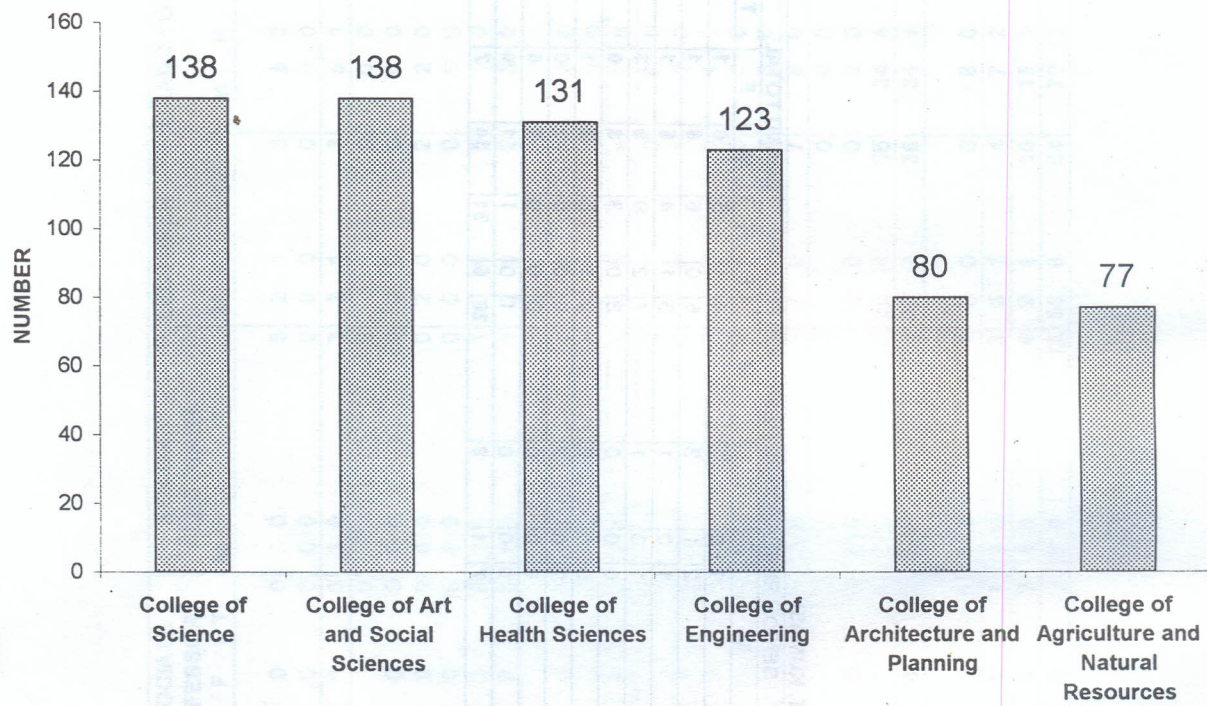
