






ABSTRACT

The objective of this publication is to present to our guests and the general public attending the 50th congregation, statistical information about the Kwame Nkrumah University of Science and Technology (KNUST). The information presented in the booklet covers the staff strength and students' population of the University for the 2015/2016 academic year.

For the 2015/2016 academic year, 34,607 applications were received but only 20,895 could be admitted – of which 14,475 enrolled – mainly due to limited academic facilities. The student population was 42,561 made up of 27,283 (64.1%) males and 15,278 (35.9%) females.

International students' population was 1,229 with distribution for males and females being 675 and 554 respectively. The nationality of the foreign students was distributed over 35 countries.

The staff strength of the University is 3,229 comprising 925 senior members, 1,128 senior staff and 1,176 junior staff. Comment, suggestions and corrections for the improvement of the publications are most welcome and should be addressed to the Quality Assurance and Planning Unit, Vice-Chancellor's office, Kwame Nkrumah University of Science and Technology.



The Emblem




AND SLOGAN

The Emblem of the Kwame Nkrumah University of Science and Technology is made up of the aesthetic arrangement of six distinct elements. These elements are relevant to the prime objectives of the University - Teaching, Research and Service to humanity. They are a Pot of Fire, Calipers, a Golden Stool, an Eagle with outstretched wings, Green leaves and a slogan.

The Slogan:

"Nyansapo wosane no badwenna" (the knot of Wisdom is untied only by the wise) indicates the goal of the University which is to produce the highly skilled manpower required for the technological advancement of Ghana and Africa.

Green Leaves:



These leaves stand for the land and its rich natural resources. The tree that produces these leaves is called "Adwunu". Leaves from the Adwunu tree are used for purification. The green leaves, therefore, also signify the purification of the minds.

The Stool:



This is a symbol of traditional authority, reinforcing the maxim: "Knowledge is Power". The stool consists of three parts - the seat, the middle portion with a motif and the base. The colour of the stool is good.

The Calipers:



This tool which is used by a cross-section of scientists and technologies represents science and technology as the foundation or the cornerstone of the development and progress of the country.

The Pot of fire:



The pot signifies the storehouse of knowledge. The flame represents the quest for knowledge which should be kept alive and burning always.

The Eagle:



The eagle is the king of birds. it soars gracefully higher and faster across the sky than all the birds. Eagles are also endowed with keen eyesight.



FIGURE 2: APPLICATION & ADMISSION INFORMATION BY COLLEGES, 2015/2016, KNUST



FIGURE 3: UNDERGRADUATE APPLICATION & ADMISSION INFORMATION BY COLLEGES, 2015/2016, KNUST



FIGURE 4: GRADUATE APPLICATION AND ADMISSION INFORMATION BY COLLEGES, 2015/2016, KNUST



FIGURE 5: GRADUATE APPLICATION AND ADMISSION INFORMATION BY PROGRAMMES, 2015/2016, KNUST



FIGURE 6: STUDENTS' ENROLMENT BY COLLEGE, 2015/2016, KNUST




FIGURE 7: GRADUATE STUDENTS' ENROLMENT BY GENDER AND PROGRAMME, 2015/2016, KNUST





FIGURE 11: STUDENTS' ENROLMENT AND OUTPUT 1961-2015




FIGURE 12: TREND OF APPLICANTS, QUALIFIED AND ADMITTED, FROM 1999-2016




